When Interior Base Plate "Lock Down" is in the Disengaged or Unlocked (Green) Position, simply turn the lever up or down on the Exterior Trim and enter.

ENTRY - LOCKED POSITION

When the Interior Base Plate "Lock Down" is in Engaged or Locked (Red) Position, entry is prevented when your credentials or you enter your pin into the access control system. Key Override WILL NOT override the Locked Position.



ENTRY with Key Override and Lock Down is UNLOCKED

In the event of a power outage the door may be opened IF the LKM10K Lock Down is in the **Vertical "Unlocked" Position.** To use the Key Override, insert the key into the Key Override cylinder and turn ir in either direction. With the key turned the external lever handle can be turned up or down to open the door. The key can be removed once the door is open and will relock once the door closes and latches. Essentially the Key Override can be turned to the Key Override can be turned to the Key Override can be turned up or down to open the door.



ENTRY with Key Override and Lock Down LOCKED

act as a manual access control.

The Key Override function DOES NOT work when the Lock Down is in the Horizontal "Locked" Position, so entry is not permitted. Egress is always available.



Horizontal "Engaged" Position - LOCKED



Vertical "Disengaged" Position - UNLOCKED

EXIT

Single motion egress is always possible with a push or a pull of the LKM10K handle. A luminescent push or pull sticker tells what motion is needed to open the door.

No matter what condition the access control system or Lock Down is in (Engaged or Disengaged), exiting the area is never impeded.
